Role Overview

Maple Counseling seeks a Clinical Supervisor to join our professional team.

Maple Counseling is a non-profit 501(c)3 whose mission is to provide low-cost mental health services to individuals of all ages, couples, and families throughout Los Angeles County, and to provide clinical training for graduate and postgraduate students working towards licensure in the mental health field. Maple Counseling is known for the quality of our clinical training, our expertise in psychodynamic work, and the collegial atmosphere of the clinical staff. This year we will celebrate our 50th Year Anniversary of dedicated service to the community.

It is an exciting time to join Maple Counseling. In late 2022, we will move to our brand-new facility in mid-city Los Angeles, and look forward to new programs and growth. In addition to shaping the professional development of future clinicians, the Clinical Supervisor will participate in the evolution of a training organization. Maple Counseling aspires to be the premier training site in Los Angeles for pre-licensed mental health clinicians. This goal can only be met with a stellar team of experienced senior therapists who supervise, train and mentor our interns.

The ideal candidate will be an engaging supervisory group facilitator with a wealth of clinical experience treating individual adults and couples. Expertise in trauma treatment is particularly desirable. There will be opportunity to teach and train, as well as connect with a dynamic team of colleagues and the many alumni of Maple Counseling in the larger clinical community.

At the present time, supervision groups and staff meetings are conducted via remote platforms. When our new clinic opens and public health (COVID) conditions allow, in-person supervision groups and staff meetings will resume.

CLINICAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct weekly group supervision with up to eight interns treating adults and couples.
- Guide interns in clinical interventions consistent with psychodynamic theory.
- Facilitate group discussion and intern case presentations.
- Monitor cases for risk/reporting/legal issues. Respond to clinical emergencies and guide interns through challenging client issues.
- Using an electronic health record, review/approve clinical documentation (signing off on intern progress notes, treatment plans, etc.).
- Sign off on intern hours of experience toward licensure.
- Provide interns with ongoing clinical and professional feedback, verbally and via written evaluations.

ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Oversee intern compliance with Maple Counseling policy and terms of agreement (adequate caseloads, prompt submission of documentation, support of Maple Counseling policy with clients, etc.).
- Evaluate skill development of assigned interns. Provide written feedback as required by the graduate schools.
- Keep the Clinical Director fully informed of any potential legal or ethical issues that may impact the integrity of Maple Counseling.
- Interview and select intern applicants for incoming training cohorts.
- Participate in weekly staff and consultation meetings.
- Consultation with administrative staff as needed.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Active clinical license in CA: Psychologist, LCSW or LMFT.
- Minimum of 5 years post licensure experience.
- Strong clinical (psychodynamic) background is essential. In addition, experience in other treatment approaches is welcome.
- Ability to effectively teach clinical interventions and provide feedback that fosters professional growth.
- Qualified to supervise Trainees and Associates in CA per BBS requirements.
- Expertise in couple's therapy strongly preferred.
- Expertise in trauma treatment strongly preferred.
- Experience with an electronic health record (EHR) strongly preferred.
